

Meeting Summary (7/18/2009 Draft)

CLAGGETT CREEK WATERSHED COUNCIL

5:30 pm – 6:25 pm, Wednesday, July 1, 2009

Attendees: Dennis Koho, Jeff Anderson, David Philbrick, Kate Tarter, Patty Tipton

Dennis Koho called the meeting to order, the notes for the June 3 meeting were approved.

1. Jeff and Dennis are continuing to help Mark water the trees planted along Claggett Creek.
2. Kate mentioned two potential projects for the CCWC. One is at the Kroc Center Park as part of the “Days of Caring” in September. The second is with McKay High School. She considers both as opportunities to partner with others on projects that would both help further work along Claggett Creek and the CCWC. Helping on these projects would increase the number of successful projects carried out by the Claggett Creek Watershed Council and would increase the number of hours that can be used for matching other projects. Both factors increase our ability to obtain future grant support. Kate was verbally supported by the steering committee on these two projects and she agreed to continue to let everyone know about their status via email. Kate was very impressed by the documentation Mark Caillier put together for the work to plant trees along Claggett Creek on May 30.
3. Dennis committed to follow up with Luca (sp?) at the Soil and Watershed Council regarding possible funding opportunities to help carry out a stream improvement project on Claggett Creek on the northwest corner of River and Lockhaven.
4. Given the low turn out and number of conflicts, it was agreed to cancel the August CCWC meeting. The next meeting will be Wednesday, September 2. A commitment was made to communicate via email if something should arise in the interim.
