PROJECT NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

Partnerships: City of Keizer

Goals Accomplished: Cut back reed canary grass and other invasives three feet from native trees and shrubs, tagged natives. Country Glenn Park project not completed due to lack of volunteers.

Lessons Learned: Residential weed eater string breaks within a few seconds when cutting reed canary grass and ineffective on woody invasives. Try “bush rig” with metal blade next time. Must do removal by hand near native vegetation.
