**PROJECT NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION**

**Partnerships:** SOLV, PGE and the City of Keizer

**Goals:** Annual SOLV IT Project. Maintenance (removing invasive grasses from around trees) and assessment of the northwest bank planting of Ash trees at Claggett Creek Park. Planting 11 Hawthorne trees at County Glenn Park on the north side of Labish Creek.

Due to high water at Claggett Creek Park only three trees were planted by three volunteers to assist in bank stabilization. Volunteers were routed to Country Glenn Park where trees, shrubs and native plants were planted

**Lesson Learned:** Have a backup project that can be expanded to accommodate an unexpected increase in volunteers.
